**Hans Schreier, Ph.D., Professor**

Institute for Resources, Environment and Sustainability at UBC

*“Local and World Water Resources, Present and Future ”*

Hans Schreier is a professor at the Institute for Resources, Environment and Sustainability at The University of British Columbia in Vancouver. His research interests include watershed analysis (system dynamics, simulation modeling); Geographic Information Systems (GIS); land/water interactions (land use and its impact on water resources); non-point source pollution and cumulative effects; water and soil quality and pollution (excess nutrients, trace metals, sediments); geomorphological and pedological processes; and land degradation processes and rehabilitation.

Hans Schreier has spent a career making a difference in the lives of Canadians and people around the world. His ability to translate his knowledge and research into real and useable information has put him at the forefront of watershed and water reuse issues around the world. He can speak the language of the water manager in Vancouver, the teenager in Central America or the village elder in Nepal. Hans' contribution to water issues is too great to ever be measured.
